Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, we have been providing an 'In-School Offer' for vulnerable students and children of key workers since the start of the nationwide lockdown. This provision will continue when we also start to welcome back students from Year 10 and Year 12 for some face to face contact from Monday 15th June.

We recognise that following recent government announcements, more parents/carers that are categorised as key workers* may need to utilise our 'In-School Offer' as they return to work. In order to support our planning, if you are a key worker and wish for your child to access our 'In-School Offer' (regardless of whether they have accessed it previously or not), please complete the form at the link below by Friday 5th June. If your child is in Year 10 and you intend for them to access the Year 10 offer, there is no need to complete the form. However, please be aware that guidance published by the government recommends that students do not mix groups. Consequently, a Year 10 student would not be able to access both the in-school offer for Year 10 and the provision for vulnerable students and children of key workers.

After you have registered your child, we will send you an email at the start of next week providing you with more details. In line with our ethos of excellence, the in-school provision will focus on the following areas;

- Provide time and support for students to access their remote learning activities.
- Provide time for supervised daily physical activity.
- Include teacher led sessions developing global understanding.
- Provide wrap-around care for students, considering their individual needs and well-being.

The school day will run from 8.45am (students can arrive from 8.15am) to 2.45pm with the exception of Wednesdays when students will leave at 2pm to allow for a deep clean each week. Typical daily cleans will continue on the other days of the week. Students will be allocated to a specific small sized group and they will remain in this group allowing us to adhere to social distancing measures the government have published for educational settings.

Our 'In-School Offer' for children of key workers and vulnerable students will be led by Kris Hartley (KHartley@george-spencer.notts.sch.uk) and myself (JDakers@george-spencer.notts.sch.uk) who are both experienced members of the senior leadership team.
