We will be focusing on our family members and talking about why they are special to us and how we are connect. We will also be looking at similarities and differences.



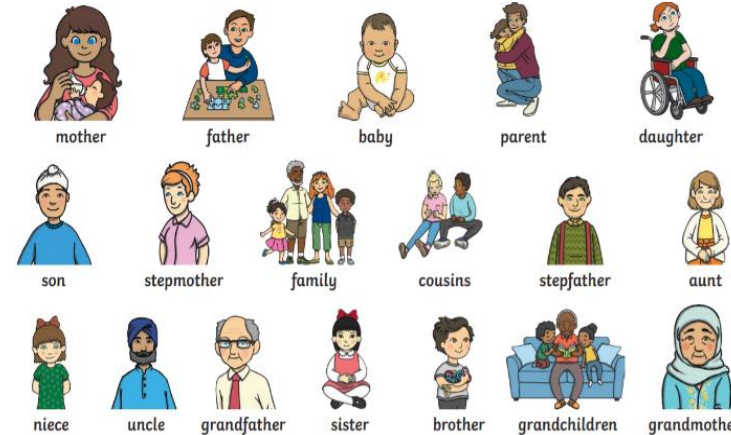
Activities you can do at home:

Your family is so important and unique to your child. Why don't you explore your family tree, share old pictures, visit your relatives and learn about their experiences?



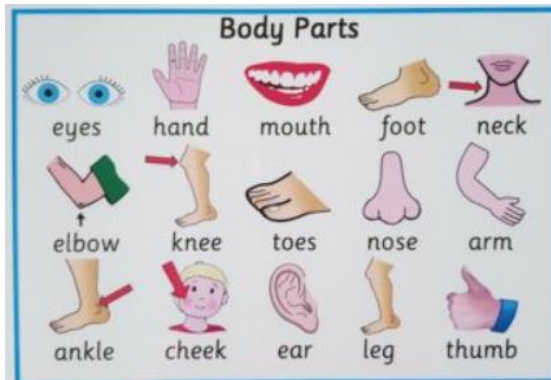
We explore our emotions and go through scenarios to help us understand our feelings.
