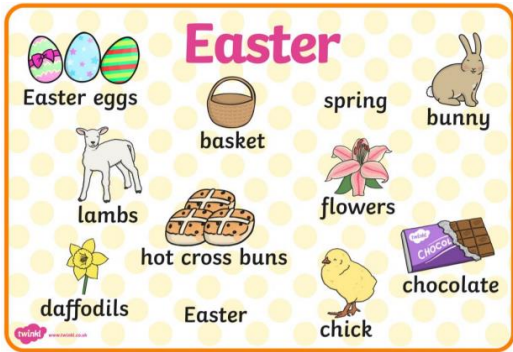


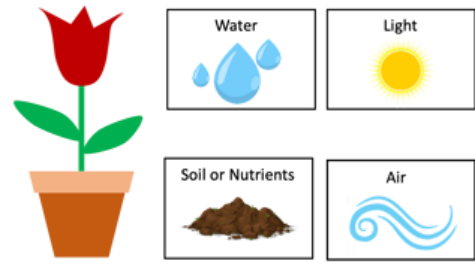


EYFS Knowledge Organiser – How Does Your Garden Grow?

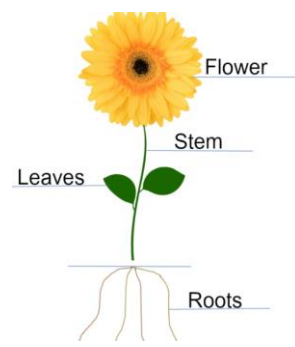
